### TERMS & CONDITIONS

These terms & conditions have been set to ensure that everyone staying here has a safe and pleasant stay! If you have any concerns about this information please contact us at our office.

BOOKINGS- Advance bookings are recommended to avoid disappointment. You can make an enquiry via our web site or telephone. A completed booking form & cheque deposit will secure your booking. This deposit is non-refundable, however will be deducted from the total cost of your stay. There is a 3 night minimum stay on Bank holiday weekends. Pitches are available from 2pm on the first day of your stay and should be vacated by 11am on your final day(unless prior arrangement.) Please report to the office on your arrival.

PITCH SPACING- Caravans should be parked to the left of the pitch to allow space for awning and one vehicle. Only one vehicle per pitch- additional parking is available upon request.

FIRE- Open fires are NOT allowed- BBQ's may be used provided that they are not placed directly onto the grass. Fire extinguishers are positioned on the site in the case of fire.(please see fire safety instructions attached on fire extinguishers!)Please ensure they are not tampered with and any used extinguishers should be immediately reported to the site office.

WATER-Taps are positioned in both fields-the water supply is metered so please refrain from using hose pipes and ensure the taps are closed after use.

WASTE- Skips are provided at the entrance to the site, this should be used for household rubbish only (items such as batteries ,bbq and large items must not be thrown into the skip) No loose rubbish please.Bags should be tightly secured.

RE-CYCLING- Bins are provided for glass bottles, cans & plastic please use these to keep our environment green! Please rinse dirty containers before placing in the re-cycling bins.

GROUND SHEETS- Placed directly onto the grass should be preferably made of breathable fabric to avoid damage to the grass.

CHILDREN- Are most welcome here- please remember that it is the parents responsibility to supervise them at all times. There is a playground for children (to be used in daylight hours only.) Please ensure that any ball games are controlled as not to cause nuisance to others. Children are asked not to play out after 11pm and noise to be kept to a minimum.

PRIVACY- of other site users should be considered this is a family site and therefore noise levels should be reduced after 11p.m.Noisy groups or bad language will NOT be tolerated. Vehicles should not enter the site after midnight.

SITE SECURITY- The main lights in the shower block are switched off at midnight however night lights are in operation throughout the night. Power boats and jet skis to be parked off site in a provided area off the main site.(Health & Safety regulations)

SPEED LIMIT- Please adhere to the 5MPH limit in force.
